GENERAL POLICY

Alberta GFOA will recognize individuals who volunteer their services to the Association.

A volunteer is defined as an individual who is an Alberta GFOA member who serves on 1) the Board of Directors, 2) one or more of the Task Forces, 3) the Conference Committee and/or 4) the Committee on Canadian Issues.

Recognition

Recognition is an important component of volunteer services and is often the only way in which the Association can say "thank you" to a volunteer. Although individual, informal recognition of volunteers should be ongoing, it is important that volunteers be recognized formally on a regular basis, at least annually.

It will be the Alberta GFOA Board's responsibility to coordinate the above-mentioned recognition.

Board Members

Board Members, upon retirement from the Board, will be presented with a plaque acknowledging the dedicated service of the individual.

Task Force Members

Task Force Members, upon retirement from the Task Force, will be recognized as determined by the Alberta GFOA Board, taking into consideration tenure of each recipient.

Conference Committee

The annual Conference Committee will be recognized by the Alberta GFOA Board.

Committee on Canadian Issues

CCI representatives, upon retirement from CCI, will be presented with a token of appreciation to be determined by the Alberta GFOA Board.

Review and Amendment Procedures

The Alberta GFOA's Volunteer Recognition Policy shall be reviewed annually by the Board of Directors who may approve any changes as required.
