Pension Reform Bills Killed

Premier Jim Prentice has prorogued the fall legislative session by two weeks to allow time for by-elections and a new throne speech. The prorogation brings to an end all business and legislation on the Order Paper before the Legislative Assembly.

In effect the prorogue will end and kill two bills which include the Public Sector Pension Plans Amendment Act (Bill 9) and the Employment Pension (Private Sector) Plans Amendment Act (Bill 10). These will not be reintroduced under the Prentice government.
